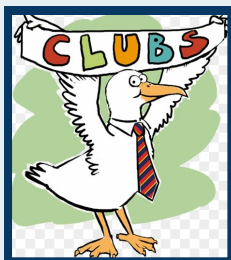

PTFA Meeting

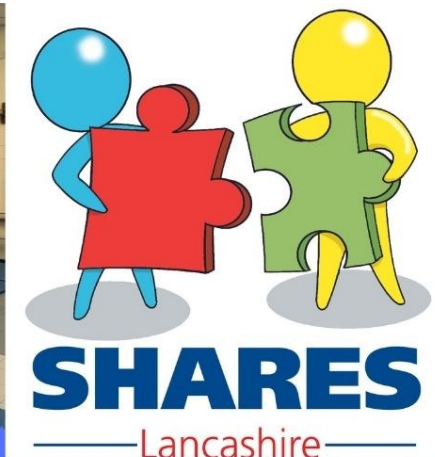
